After School Enrichment and Safety (ASES) Program

The After School Enrichment and Safety (ASES) Program will open the first day of school and operates every school day through the last day of school. To comply with State and Federal grant requirements the ASES Program will commence immediately upon the conclusion of the regular school day and operates a minimum of 15 hours per week and at least until 6:00 PM on every regular school day. We pride ourselves in creating a safe, engaging, positive setting for our students. To get the most out of their time in the program, students need to attend each day and stay for the entire program.

3:05-6:00 p.m.

Wednesday
1:35-6:00 p.m.

Each year the target population differs depending on the school and student needs. This year our ASES program is currently open to Cole 1st – 6th graders, **free of charge**. Our target population this year is foster youth, homeless, English learners, intervention students and student/families that need the entire 3-6:00pm program.

Application submission and/or previous enrollment does not guarantee placement in the ASES program. Students may not start program until contacted by the ASES Site Coordinator.
