



Cole Elementary School Fundraising Sale For 6th Grade Camp

Beginning on Thursday, November 15, Cole's sixth grade students will start selling candy to help offset some of the cost for the sixth grade trip to Sonora in February. This is NOT a mandatory fundraiser. Students who choose not to participate will still be able to go to camp and pay the full price.

Cole Elementary has teamed up with the World's Finest Chocolate Company. They will be providing the candy bars to sell for \$1.00 each. Students will receive a CREDIT of \$.50 for each candy bar sold. The bars come in boxes of 60, so students earn \$30.00 towards the cost of camp for every box of candy sold. The sixth grade camp at the Sierra Outdoor School (SOS) will cost each student \$180.00. Cole Elementary does not profit from this fundraiser. This is strictly an opportunity for students to work and raise money for their camp costs. Many students pay their entire Sonora trip by selling these candy bars.

- Family members may offer to help by taking chocolate to work and by asking friends and relatives. However, participation is voluntary. Parents are responsible for the care of World's Finest Chocolate Company candy bars and all money collected from sales. **All candy money is due Monday, December 17, 2018.** Please remember, we cannot return open boxes so, **once a box is opened the student is responsible to return the money for the entire box** (they may then sell the remainder to recoup the money).
